**National Health Service** we will remove all forms of private investment from the NHS and abolish private health care. There's plenty of money to cut waiting lists and re-open community hospitals. We would start by recouping the billions taken from the country by wealthy tax avoiders. We would re-invest in hands on patient care the billions more wasted on unnecessary drugs marketed to make money for drugs companies

**Housing:** employing unemployed construction workers, we would embark on a programme of house building focused on areas of need and funded from the capital receipts held by local authorities from the sale of council houses. We would restore rent controls, reverse the transfer of public housing to private or 'social' landlords and re-instate housing benefit for young people

**Work and Pensions:** funded from the billions we would save by scrapping trident and other weapons systems designed for waging wars abroad, the SLP would introduce a National Minimum Wage of £12 per hour. From the hundreds of billions invested in private pension schemes, our country can easily afford to provide a pension at age 65 equivalent to the average wage

**European Union:** unlike all the 'major' parties, Socialist Labour is opposed to British membership of ANY global blocs, treaties or pacts designed to override the economic and political needs of our people. Apart from the EU, we would withdraw from NATO, the WTO, the TTIP negotiations and end the military pact with America. We would keep Britain out of the 'single market' which is not about 'opportunity' but running a black market of low paid, non unionised labour, selling our industries to ruthless corporations and contracting out our public services to private 'investors'. The SLP wants a publicly accountable economy serving the life needs of our people not the greed of multi national corporations. Instead of seeking to dominate and control other nations we would stay out of foreign wars, trading with all nations as partners
